



JAVELIN / Topper ISO EUROCUP

26 - 31 July 2019 on the IJsselmeer at Workum

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority for the regatta is the Netherlands Javelin class organization and the Dutch chapter under governance of the International ISO class organization (UK).

2. RULES

The Championship will be governed by:

- The World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)2017 2020.
- The sailing instructions.
- If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will prevail.
- For the Skiff handicap class, handicap will be based on the SW rating.

3. AMENDMENTS

The Organizing Authority reserves the right to amend this notice of race. Subsequent changes will also be posted on the regatta notice board.

4. ADVERTISING

The regatta will be classified as a Category C Event in accordance with Appendix 1 of the RRS. Competing boats may be required to display advertising of the Event Sponsor, on each side of the boat, on the forward 25% of the hull.

5. ELIGIBILITY

Competitors shall meet the requirements of RRS Appendix 2, and have paid the entry fee for the regatta. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The Organizing Authority will not stipulate a maximum number of entries.

6. ENTRIES

For Javelin registration can be done on:

<u>www.javelin.nl</u> or by email to <u>wedstrijd@javelin.nl</u> before 1th of July or. Payment for Dutch crews will be done by direct debit. English and German crews will pay cash at the event. Entry fee will be \in 280,- per boat and includes entry to the BBQ and the Captains dinner for the skipper and crew. Additional persons are welcome to join the BBQ and Captains dinner against \in 22,- per person, per event.

Prepayment/pre-entry before may 1st 2019 give € 15,- discount.

For ISO registration can be done on:

Non full members pay \in 215,- (including a one year ISO class membership) There are additional costs for the captain's dinner/BBQ of \in 44,- per person for two evenings.

For Buzz registration can be done on:

Via registration link or <u>isosailingec2019@gmail.com</u>. Entry fee will be: \in 195,- for full Buzz class members (UK and ITA) and includes entry to the social events for the skipper and the crew. Non full members pay \in 215,- (including a one year ISO class membership) There are additional costs for the captain's dinner/BBQ of \in 44,- per person for two evenings. In case of a turn up lower than 5 boats the Buzz class will be added to the skiff handicap class

For Skiff handicap registration can be done on:

Entry fee will be: \in 195,- for double handed Skiff and \in 135,- for single handed Skiff sailing boats and includes entry to the social events for the skipper and the crew. There are additional costs for the captain's dinner/BBQ of \in 44,- per person for two evenings.

8. REGISTRATION

Final registration will take place at the Regatta Office at the following time: 26 July between 11:00 - 13:00 and 26 July 20:00 - 21:00

9. MEASUREMENT

Javelin:

- A valid Javelin Class measurement certificate shall be present for each boat.
- Upon request boats may be subject to further inspections during the event and shall be performed by the responsible persons of the javelin class associations.
- There will be a forklifter at 16.00 to weigh unmeasured boats.
- A valid class membership shall be present for each boat.

ISO:

- Upon request boats may be subject to further inspections during the event and shall be performed by the responsible persons of the ISO class association.
- There will be a forklifter at 16.00 to weigh unmeasured boats.
- A valid class membership shall be present for each boat.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

A printed copy of the sailing instructions for each competitor will be available upon registration at the Regatta Office

11. COURSES

The courses will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

12. SCORING

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A of the RRS will apply. A minimum of four races shall be completed to constitute the Euro Cup.

For ISO, The Cup will be calculated based on the races sailed from 27th up till the 30th of July. Spare day for racing, if applicable, will be added with additional price giving.

13. JURY

A Jury will be constituted for the Euro Cup in accordance with Appendix M of the RRS and the decisions of the Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.4. The right of appeal is denied.

14. PRIZES

For each separate class prizes will be awarded for the Euro Cup for the top three crews. Additional daily prizes and sport prizes can be awarded.

15. LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

Competitors who participate in the Javelin/Topper ISO Euro Cup 2019 are entirely at their own risk (See Rule 4, Decision to Race). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for personal or material damage, injury or death, sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. It shall be the sole and inescapable responsibility of the competitor to have such insurance and to provide written proof thereof to the Organizing Authority upon request.

16. ACCOMMODATION
